Construction Starts on High-Rise Condo Project

The south end of Penticton will be taking on a new look in the near future with the introduction of Pilot Pacific's newest project. Alysen Place is the new high-rise condominium residence which will be constructed near Skaha Lake Road and Guelph Avenue.

It will consist of three buildings, seven and eight storeys tall, complemented by landscaped grounds which will include a water feature, gazebo and outdoor fire pit surrounded by walking paths and benches throughout.

Phase 1 of Alysen Place is scheduled to come to market this spring with the developer, Pilot Pacific Developments Inc., currently completing a sales presentation centre at Skaha Lake Road and Yorkton Avenue which will include a designer furnished two-bedroom and den show-suite.

Construction is under way with completion of the first phase in the fall of 2007.

Alysen Place condominium suites in Phase 1 will range in size from 850 square feet for a one bedroom plus den suite to 1,655 square feet for two bedroom plus den penthouse.
